Fire Department update. Gary reported on the purchase of a 2009 engine that replaces the 1993 that is currently being used. The Michigan truck is in the hands of attorneys at the moment trying to get the money back that was invested. They are having a BBQ on the 31st to coincide with the Village wide garage sales.

In the Mayor's report Heidi informed the Board she would like to attend the Naturally Lewis economic conference. In the clerk/treasurer report, the current financials are included in the packet. Conversation was had about trading in or selling the bobcat skid steer and getting a compact tractor for the Village as we think we could do more around the Village with a tractor and attachments.

We are going to try and get a spraying done by the end of the month for mosquitos.
